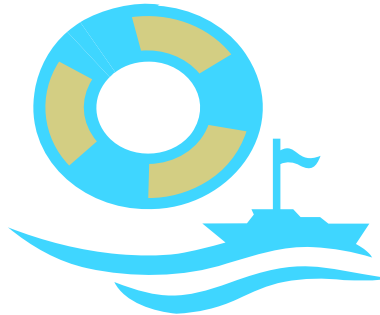

** The Safety Check is Free and usually takes not more than half an hour.

Boat owners who are interested in finding out how well their boats comply with Federal and State recreational boating safety and environmental laws, can take advantage of the US Coast Guard Auxiliary Vessel Safety Check Program. Boats are checked by qualified Auxiliary Vessel Examiners. In the event that an issue is found, the Vessel Examiner will be happy to return to complete the inspection when the deficiency has been corrected.

Boats that pass the safety check will be provided with a Vessel Safety Check Decal that will be affixed to the boat to show current compliance with all safety requirements and regulations. Boaters with a Vessel Safety Check Decal may qualify for safe-boater discounts available from most marina insurance companies.
